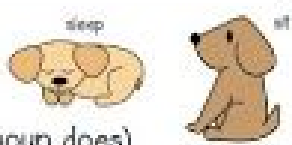

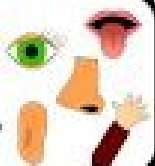

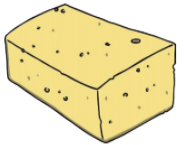
Topic
